### Mishima Taisha Shrine at Mishima

The root god of Mt. Fuji has been enshrined here from ancient times. Attracting around 3 million worshippers in a year, this shrine ranks as the 1st degree shrine in this district.



### Mishima Summer Festival

The largest festival of Mishima in summer. In the night, "shagiri"(traditional festival music) players got together in front of Mishima Taisha Shrine and compete with each other.



### Mt. Fuji

Mt. Fuji, the most highest mountain in Japan, is a symbol for Japan. Many climbers come from in and outside the country in every summer.



### Fuji Five Lake
